And there's another record that is long overdue to be broken. For decades, George Webb Restaurants have been predicting that our Brewers will win 12 games in a row. In 1987, Webb's celebrated their prediction by serving nearly 170,000 free hamburgers when the Brewers started the season 13-0. Last year, we came close three times. With three times the charm, this could be the year the Brewers, once again, win 12 games straight.
