**GEORGE WEBB PREDICTS MILWAUKEE BREWERS
WILL WIN 12 STRAIGHT**

May 5, 2005 (Waukesha, WI) For as long as most Wisconsinites can remember, George Webb Restaurants has predicted consecutive victories for Milwaukee's baseball teams. This prediction goes back to the 1940s when Webb predicted 17 consecutive wins for the Brewers team of the American Association. Although Webb had never said what he'd do if the Brewers won 12 straight, three days later George Webb Restaurants were handing out free burgers to residents throughout the state. From noon to 8pm on April 22nd, George Webb Restaurants served more than 168,194 hamburgers to celebratory fans.
